Residency requirements for family payments

Holders of partner provisional or interdependency visas may receive the payments listed below if they are temporarily outside Australia for an approved reason.

- Family Tax Benefit
- Parental Leave Pay or Dad and Partner Pay, or
- Double Orphan Pension.

However, holders of temporary protection visas cannot receive payments while outside Australia for any reason.

Family Tax Benefit

To be eligible for Family Tax Benefit Part A and Part B, you must satisfy residency requirements. You must be living in Australia and:

- have Australian citizenship
- hold a permanent visa
- hold a special category visa, or
- hold a certain temporary visa type, for example a partner provisional, interdependency or temporary protection visa.

Your child must also meet the residency requirements or be living with you.

You must continue to meet the residency requirements for as long as you get this payment.

Paid Parental Leave scheme

To be eligible for Parental Leave Pay you must satisfy the residency requirements from the date your child is born, or comes into your primary care, until the last day of your payment.

To be eligible for Dad and Partner Pay you must meet the residency requirements for each day you receive the payment.

When your child is born or comes into your primary care, you must be living in Australia and:

- have Australian citizenship
- hold a permanent visa
- hold a special category visa

- hold a certain temporary visa type, for example a partner provisional, interdependency or temporary protection visa.

Parenting Payment

To be eligible for Parenting Payment, you must satisfy residency requirements. You must be an Australian resident and you must:

- have been an Australian resident for a period, or periods, that total 104 weeks, or
- be exempt from this requirement—for example, if you are a refugee or have become a single parent during your most recent period of Australian residence.

You must also meet residency requirements on the day you lodge your claim and for as long as you get this payment. Generally, you will need to be physically present in Australia on the day you lodge your claim.

If you have lived or worked in a country with which Australia has an international social security agreement, it may help you meet these residency requirements.

Carer Allowance

To be eligible for Carer Allowance, you must satisfy residency requirements. You and the person you are caring for must:

- be Australian residents
- continue to meet the residency requirements for as long as you get this payment, and
- be physically present in Australia on the day you lodge your claim.

Double Orphan Pension

To be eligible for Double Orphan Pension, you must satisfy residency requirements. You must be living in Australia and:

- have Australian citizenship
- hold a permanent visa
- hold a special category visa, or
- hold either a partner provisional, interdependency or temporary protection visa.

Your child must also meet the residency requirements or be living with you.

You must also continue to meet the residency requirements for as long as you get this payment.

If you have lived or worked in a country with which Australia has an international social security agreement, it may help you meet these residency requirements.
