



Boravišni uvjeti koje je potrebno zadovoljavati za dobivanje obiteljskog doplatka

Nosioci partner provisional ili interdependency visas će možda imati pravo nastaviti primati niženavedene doplatke i tokom perioda u kojem se, iz opravdanih razloga, budu privremeno nalazili izvan Australije:

- Family Tax Benefit
- Parental Leave Pay ili Dad and Partner Pay, ili
- Double Orphan Pension.

Međutim, nosioci temporary protection visas ne mogu primati ove isplate dok se, bez obzira iz kojih razloga, nalaze izvan Australije.

Family Tax Benefit

Da biste stekli pravo na Family Tax Benefit Part A i Part B, morate zadovoljavati boravišne uvjete. Morate živjeti u Australiji i:

- imati australsko državljanstvo
- biti nosioc permanentne vize
- biti nosioc special category visa, ili
- biti nosioc određenih oblika privremene vize, na primjer: partner provisional, interdependency ili temporary protection visa.

Vaše dijete takođe mora udovoljavati boravišnim uvjetima ili živjeti sa vama.

Sve dok budete primali ovaj doplatok, moraćete nastaviti udovoljavati boravišnim uvjetima.

Paid Parental Leave scheme

Da biste stekli pravo na Parental Leave Pay morate zadovoljavati boravišne uvjete sve od datuma rođenja vašeg djeteta ili od datuma kada se budete počeli brinuti za njega kao primarni staratelj, pa sve do zadnjeg dana isplate.

Da biste imali pravo na Dad and Partner Pay, morate zadovoljavati boravišne uvjete tokom svakog dana za koji budete primali ovaj doplatok.

Kad vam se rodi dijete ili od trenutka kada postanete djetetov primarni staratelj, morate živjeti u Australiji i:

- imati australsko državljanstvo
- biti nosioc permanentne vize
- biti nosioc special category visa
- biti nosioc određene vrste privremene vize, npr. partner provisional, interdependency ili temporary protection visa.

Parenting Payment

Da biste stekli pravo na Parenting Payment, morate zadovoljavati boravišne uvjete. Morate biti australski državljanin i morate:

- stanovati u Australiji tokom određenog perioda ili niza perioda koji ukupno moraju iznositi najmanje 104 sedmice, ili
- biti izuzeti od ovog uslova —na primjer, ako ste izbjeglica ili ako ste postali samohrani roditelj tokom zadnjeg perioda vašeg boravka u Australiji.

Takođe, moraćete zadovoljavati boravišne uvjete na datum kada budete ulagali molbu za primanje ovog doplatka, sve do zadnjeg dana dok ga budete primali. U principu, moraćete biti fizički prisutni u Australiji na dan kada budete ulagali molbu.

Ako ste živjeli ili radili u zemlji s kojom Australija ima međunarodni ugovor o socijalnoj skrbi, možda će vam to pomoći da zadovoljite navedene boravišne uvjete.

Carer Allowance

Da biste imali pravo na Carer Allowance, morat ćete zadovoljavati boravišne uvjete. Vi i osoba za koju se brinete morate:

- biti australski državljani
- nastaviti udovoljavati boravišnim uvjetima tokom cijelog perioda dok budete primali ovaj doplatka, i
- biti fizički prisutni u Australiji na dan ulaganja molbe.

Double Orphan Pension

Da biste stekli pravo na Double Orphan Pension, morate udovoljavati boravišnim uvjetima. Morate živjeti u Australiji i:

- imati australsko državljanstvo
- biti nosioc permanentne vize
- biti nosioc special category visa, ili

- biti nosioc partner provisional, interdependency ili temporary protection visa.

Vaše dijete takođe mora zadovoljavati boravišne uvjete ili živjeti sa vama.

Takođe, moraćete nastaviti zadovoljavati boravišne uvjete tokom cijelog perioda dok budete primali ovaj doplatak.

Ako ste živjeli ili radili u zemlji s kojom Australija ima međunarodni ugovor o socijalnoj skrbi, možda će vam to pomoći da zadovoljite navedene boravišne uvjete.

Napomena: pozivi s kućnog telefona na brojeve koji počinju s '13' iz bilo kojeg dijela Australije naplaćuju se po fiksnoj tarifi. Ona se može razlikovati od cijene lokalnog poziva, a tarifa joj može varirati ovisno o telefonskoj kompaniji koju koristite. Pozivi s kućnog telefona na '1800' brojeve su besplatni. Pozivi s javnih i mobilnih telefona će se možda naplaćivati zavisno o njihovoj dužini, tj. po višoj cijeni.



Residency requirements for family payments

Holders of partner provisional or interdependency visas may receive the payments listed below if they are temporarily outside Australia for an approved reason.

- Family Tax Benefit
- Parental Leave Pay or Dad and Partner Pay, or
- Double Orphan Pension.

However, holders of temporary protection visas cannot receive payments while outside Australia for any reason.

Family Tax Benefit

To be eligible for Family Tax Benefit Part A and Part B, you must satisfy residency requirements. You must be living in Australia and:

- have Australian citizenship
- hold a permanent visa
- hold a special category visa, or
- hold a certain temporary visa type, for example a partner provisional, interdependency or temporary protection visa.

Your child must also meet the residency requirements or be living with you.

You must continue to meet the residency requirements for as long as you get this payment.

Paid Parental Leave scheme

To be eligible for Parental Leave Pay you must satisfy the residency requirements from the date your child is born, or comes into your primary care, until the last day of your payment.

To be eligible for Dad and Partner Pay you must meet the residency requirements for each day you receive the payment.

When your child is born or comes into your primary care, you must be living in Australia and:

- have Australian citizenship
- hold a permanent visa
- hold a special category visa

- hold a certain temporary visa type, for example a partner provisional, interdependency or temporary protection visa.

Parenting Payment

To be eligible for Parenting Payment, you must satisfy residency requirements. You must be an Australian resident and you must:

- have been an Australian resident for a period, or periods, that total 104 weeks, or
- be exempt from this requirement—for example, if you are a refugee or have become a single parent during your most recent period of Australian residence.

You must also meet residency requirements on the day you lodge your claim and for as long as you get this payment. Generally, you will need to be physically present in Australia on the day you lodge your claim.

If you have lived or worked in a country with which Australia has an international social security agreement, it may help you meet these residency requirements.

Carer Allowance

To be eligible for Carer Allowance, you must satisfy residency requirements. You and the person you are caring for must:

- be Australian residents
- continue to meet the residency requirements for as long as you get this payment, and
- be physically present in Australia on the day you lodge your claim.

Double Orphan Pension

To be eligible for Double Orphan Pension, you must satisfy residency requirements. You must be living in Australia and:

- have Australian citizenship
- hold a permanent visa
- hold a special category visa, or
- hold either a partner provisional, interdependency or temporary protection visa.

Your child must also meet the residency requirements or be living with you.

You must also continue to meet the residency requirements for as long as you get this payment.

If you have lived or worked in a country with which Australia has an international social security agreement, it may help you meet these residency requirements.
