



Kuriha amahera y'a Child Support

Child Support ni igitigiri c'amahera arungikwa ku bavyeyi b'umwana batandukanye afasha kurera abana babo. Hariho uburyo butari buke ushobora kurungika iyo Child Support, waba uba muri Australia canke hanze y'a Australia.

Ushobora kurungika amahera y'a Child Support mu buryo wisangije, mu buryo ata wundi muntu abimenya, canke ukadusaba kubigukorera, igihe woba warasuzumwe ko ushobora kurungika amahera y'a Child Support canke warandikishije amasezerano canke ufise urwandiko rwavuye mu bucamanza, muri sentare ukarudushikiriza.

Kuriha Child Support mwibanga, (private collect)

Nimbi uriko urabisaba, canke nimba twarakoze child support assessment akwiye kuronka infashanyo, waremeye agreement canke warandikishije urwete rwavuye muri sentare, Private Collect irashoboka kuri wewe, yokora neza kuri wewe.

Private Collect iba igihe wewe hamwe n'uwo wundi muvyeyi murabiye hamwe mukumvikana ku buryo bwiza bwo kurungika amahera yo gufasha umwana wanyu hagati muri mwebwe nyene.

Ico dukora turababarira igitigiri c'amahera yo gufasha umwana gikenewe, hanyuma wewe n'uwo wundi muvyeyi mukaraba ingene muvyitunganiriza, n'igihe ayo mafaranga yo gufasha umwana yorihirwako.

Hanyuma murakwiriye kwumvikana kangahe ukwo kurungika amahera kwoba (nk'akarorero, hoba ari rimwe mw'iyinga, canke rimwe mu mayinga abiri, canke rimwe mu kwezi) n'ukugene azorungikwa (nk'akarorero, ni ayabona, canke uyarungika mu buryo bw'ibanki, canke akatwa ku mushahara).

Kwegeranya amahera y'a Child Support

Hamwe wodusaba kubikorera, tuzokwegeranya ibiva ku bavyeyi bose hanyuma dutume iyo Child Support ku muvyeyi ategerezwa kuyakira. Ibi bishobora gukoreka igihe isuzuma Child Support ryabaye, kandi tukaba twaronse izo nfashanyo zivuye ku muvyeyi ariha.

Nimbi uri umuvyeyi ariha, urashobora guhitamwo kuyaduha buri yingira, canke rimwe mu mayinga abiri, canke rimwe mu kwezi hanyuma ukanatumenyeshya ingene uzobikora, uzoyariha. Mu buryo yorihwa harimwo uguyakura ku mushahara w'umukozi, kuyakura ku mafaranga asanzwe afise muri banki, BPay, ikarata z'amahera ufise/ uheranye ukoresha Government EasyPay, ushobora kandi kuyacisha ku biro vya Australian Post canke ugakoresha ibaruwa.

Na twe duca tuyashikiriza umuvyeyi ayakira tuyacishije kuri compte yiwe yo muri Australia. Iyo uwo muvyeyi ayakira adafise agasandugu ko kuziganirizako muri banki, ashobora gutora cheque iriko amahera yo gufasha umwana tumuhaye.

Niyo umuvyeyi umwe aba canke yimukiye inyuma y'igihugu ca Australia, turashobora kwegeranya ayo mahera, iyo mfashanyo yo Child Support. Yamara, ukugene ukwo kuriha amahera kugenda, bivana n'ukugene ivyawe bihagaze, bimeze.

Nimba waratunganije Child Support mu buryo bw'iwawe utarinze gushiramwo uwundi muntu, wewe n'uwo wundi muvuyeyi, muzohitamwo ryari n'ingene Child Support izorihwa. Yamara, amakuru n'ico cose wokenera twobiguha nimbi ubishaka.

Kugereranya uburyo uronka n'ukugene woriha amafaranga y'a Child Support

Amafanga Child Support afatiye ku kubanza gusuzuma ayo usigarana uhejeje kuriha ikori ry'ayo uhembwa (amafaranga waronse umwaka uheze) ufatiye ku mwaka waheze. Nimba amafaranga waronka umwaka uheze Atari yo uronka uyu mwaka, urashobora kwemererwa kugereranya ayo uronka uyu mwaka iyo:

- isuzuma ryawe Child Support rikoresha amafaranga yasubiwemwo ufatiye ku yo wahoze usubizwa, uronka umwaka uheze, **canke**
- isuzuma ryawe Child Support rikoresha amafaranga yasubiwemwo waja waratumenyesheje imbere y'igihe, **kandi** n'igihe
- amafaranga urihira ko ikori yasubiwemwo akagabanuka ibice 15 kw'ijana canke birenga kurusha amahera waronka yakoreshe mw'isuzuma ry'a Child Support.

Nimba uja waratanze ikigereranyo c'amafaranga uzaronka uyu mwaka, urashobora kandi gutanga ikindi kigereranyo gisha c'igitigiri c'amafaranga masha ushobora kuronka.

Ntushobora gutanga ikigereranyo nimba isuzuma ryawe rifatiye kuri kimwe muri ibi bikurikira:

- amasezerano
- akintu cakozwe hamaze kubaho uguhinduka kw'ukugene isuzuma rigenda
- urwete ruvuye muri sentare.

Kugira ngo umenye uburyo bwose wemerewe gukoresha, harimwo n'ukugene ushobora kugereranya, twakure kuri **131 272**. Urashobora gukoresha form *Estimate of income* ufatiye Child Support Online Services (ubu bizwi nka CSAonline).

Child Support payment

Child Support is an amount of money transferred between separated parents used to help raise their children. There are a number of ways you can transfer Child Support, whether you live in Australia or overseas.

You can transfer Child Support payments privately or ask us to do it for you, once you have had a Child Support assessment or have registered an agreement or court order with us.

Paying Child Support privately (private collect)

If you are applying for or we have made a child support assessment, accepted an agreement or registered a court order, Private Collect may be an option that works for you.

Private Collect is when you and the other parent work out the most convenient way for child support payments to be made between yourselves.

We tell you how much child support needs to be paid and then you and the other parent make your own arrangements about how and when the payments are made.

You then need to agree how often transfers will be made (for example, weekly, fortnightly or monthly) and how they will be made (for example, cash, bank transfer or salary deduction).

Collection of Child Support payments

If you ask us to do it for you, we will collect and transfer the Child Support from the paying parent to the receiving parent. This can be done once a Child Support assessment has been made and we have received the payments from the paying parent.

If you are a paying parent, you can choose to make weekly, fortnightly or monthly payments to us and how you will make them. The payment options include employer deductions, direct credit, BPay, credit/debit cards using Government EasyPay, lodgement at an Australia Post office or by mail.

We then pay the receiving parent directly into an Australian bank account. If the receiving parent does not have access to an Australian bank account, they can receive child support from us by cheque.

If one parent lives or is moving overseas, we may still be able to collect and transfer the Child Support payments. However, the way payments are transferred will depend on your situation.

If you have arranged Child Support independently, you and the other parent will have decided when and how Child Support should be paid. However, information and help is available if you need it.

Estimating your income for Child Support payments

Child Support payments are based on an assessment of your adjusted taxable income (last year of relevant income) from a previous year. If your last year of relevant income is no longer an accurate reflection of your current income, you may be eligible to lodge an estimate of your income if:

- your current Child Support assessment uses an adjusted taxable income from your previous tax return, **or**
- your current Child Support assessment uses an adjusted taxable income that you have previously advised us, **and**
- your current adjusted taxable income has reduced by 15 per cent or more than the income used in the Child Support assessment.

If you have already lodged an estimate for this financial year, you can also lodge a new estimate for a different amount.

You may not be able to lodge an estimate if your assessment is based on one of the following:

- an agreement
- a determination made under the change of assessment process
- a court order.
