Electronic Invoicing Adoption

This measure introduces electronic invoicing (or e-invoicing). This is the electronic exchange of invoices between suppliers and buyers' financial systems.

The department is a whole-of-government e-invoicing access point providing real-time monitoring and reporting. It is accredited as an access point provider under the Trans-Tasman e-invoicing framework.

This measure is part of government policy to reduce payment terms and enable faster payments, which improves cash flow and increases productivity in the economy.

Who is affected by this measure?

This measure affects a range of stakeholders including:

- Suppliers to the department who opt-in to e-invoicing
- Participants in the Trans-Tasman e-invoicing Framework
- Government agencies which use the department as an access point
- Contract managers involved in purchasing and invoice processing

When will this start and finish?

This measure starts 2 April 2019 and is ongoing.
