New Employment Services Model — pilot and transitional arrangements

This measure has several components.

Extend access to the Online JSCI Trial

This part of the measure extends the trial of job seekers completing the Job Seeker Classification Instrument online.

Under current arrangements, eligible customers receiving Newstart Allowance and Youth Allowance (other) are chosen at random by the Department of Jobs and Small Business to be in the trial.

Until June 2022, eligible job seekers will have the option to complete the Job Seeker Classification Instrument online without the need for assistance.

Who is affected by this measure?

This measure affects job seekers looking for work including volunteers and those receiving an activity tested payment. Job seekers should contact the Department of Jobs and Small Business on 1800 805 260 about this measure.

When will this start and finish?

This part of the measure extends the trial to June 2022.

Extension of jobactive and related programs to 30 June 2022

This part of the measure extends current jobactive arrangements, complementary programs and trials.

Until June 2022, job seekers not participating in the Employment Services Model Pilot will remain able to participate in all jobactive and other complementary programs and trials without any impact to their current Mutual Obligation Requirements.

When will this start and finish?

This part of the measure continues current arrangements for a two year period, ending in June 2022.
